



INFORMATION FOR TRAVELLERS ARRIVING FROM ABROAD TO METROPOLITAN FRANCE

You are arriving from a country or territory which, in view of its health situation, characterised by an active circulation of the virus in controlled conditions, is classified as an **amber zone** defined by the Decree of 7 June, 2021 identifying areas of SARS-CoV-2 virus circulation.

According to the Decree **No. 2021-699 of 1 June, 2021**, any person coming from an "amber" list country or territory, regardless of their vaccination status, must also submit a sworn statement*:

- ✓ Attesting to the absence of COVID-19 symptoms;
- ✓ Attesting to no contact with confirmed cases of COVID-19 within 14 days of arrival.

All unvaccinated persons must also submit a sworn statement:

- ✓ Confirming they accept that a test may be carried out upon arrival into France (form to be filled out online at <https://passager.serveureos.org/>).

- If you are unable to provide this evidence, you will be denied boarding.
- Minors under the age of 12 are exempt from the measures applicable to travellers from countries on the amber list. If they are accompanied by vaccinated adults, they benefit from the rules applicable to the vaccination status of the person accompanying them on arrival.
- Presenting a negative test result upon boarding remains mandatory for minors aged 12 and over who have not been vaccinated, even if accompanied by vaccinated adults.

UPON ARRIVAL

If you are an unvaccinated person or have an incomplete vaccination status, you may be asked to carry out a **test** at the arrival airport.

Open a window for 10 minutes every hour



Wash your hands or use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser regularly



Greet others without shaking hands and avoid hugging and kissing



Cough or sneeze into your elbow
